Hello Parents,

The PAC is a group of elected parent volunteers. The PAC is the officially recognized collective voice of parents of their school. PACs are forums within each school community to discuss matters affecting your school and the education of your children.

There are benefits to having a PAC in your school. Having a PAC executive committee allows us to get a government gaming grant of \$20 per student (approx. \$6000) which we put to field trips each year. The PAC helps the school in as many areas as we can. Organize hot lunches, games nights, Freezie Fridays, Christmas Shopping Week, Sports Day, Book Fair, Family Fun Night and Grade 5 Grad among other things. We plan fundraisers so that we can pay for things such as; field trips, roller blading week and sports day ribbons, teacher appreciation and end of year trophies. In the past number of years, we have also been able to contribute to the purchase of projectors for the classrooms as well as thousands of dollars towards books for the classrooms and library.
